Forms Button on Website

We would like to make you aware of the Forms section on the CSPCA website. Go to www.cspca.com On the home page, click on the CSPCA Club Info button. You will find the Club Forms at the bottom of that drop down menu. The Premium of the 2016 Nationals will be posted there when available along with all the forms contained in the premium. This should make it easier to send in your reservations etc.

Under that button you will also find an Emergency Information Sheet. It is a good idea to keep an info sheet on each of your dogs. Should one ever get loose, you have the photo to help prove ownership etc. It is also nice to travel with just in case you are ever in an accident etc. It could help to save valuable time in an emergency. Please go take a look to see if you think the form would be of any help to you.

For all of our Committee Chairmen, your yearly reports are due to the CSPCA Secretary in September. We just need a brief summary of the status of your committee and what you have been working on. If you haven't done so yet, please take a moment to fill in a health survey on each of your Shar-Pei. We would like to see as many people participate as possible. Surveys only take about 5–10 minutes to fill out, and the information gathered is invaluable to knowing where to best spend our research dollars on health issues in the breed. You do not need to use the registered name of the dog. Call names will do or number them if you are filling out surveys on more than one dog.

For each health survey that is filled out, at the end of the year, the CSPCA will pay \$2 for each one to the CSPCA Rescue Fund and an additional \$2 per survey to the Chinese Shar-Pei Charitable Trust. Filling out the survey's helps not only know how to spend the research money but also in benefiting two of our programs.

Dr. Tintle Seminar on Shar-Pei

Autoinflammatory Disease (SPAID)

Date: Wednesday October 5, 2016

For almost two decades, the CSPCA has supported and been involved in research projects to discover why Shar-Pei are predisposed to unique health challenges. This has led to our current understanding of Shar-Pei Autoinflammatory Disease (SPAID). Dr. Linda Tintle, DVM has spearheaded these projects and been diligent in finding and collaborating with top researchers to achieve our goal of understanding the disease. Our ultimate goal is to use this knowledge to develop genetic tests that permit breeders to make informed decisions in their breeding programs that lead to better overall health for Chinese Shar-Pei.

We are very fortunate to have her dedication and expertise constantly working on the behalf of our breed. She has graciously agreed to present this seminar at our National Specialty Show. She will be updating us on all the latest research news as well as giving information on the genetic test that has been developed to assess individual risk for SPAID which includes Shar-Pei Fever, amyloidosis, otitis and cutaneous vesicular hyaluronosis (bubbles of mucin).

You will not want to miss this seminar whether you are a breeder or just interested in the health of the breed. Mark your calendars and plan your schedules so you can attend. Bring all your friends of Pei with you. If you live anywhere near York, Pennsylvania, invite your veterinarians to the seminar. Everyone is welcome.



Top 25 Invitational Update

Dear Members, please find below information related changes to the Top 25 Invitational qualification. These changes were approved by the BOD on 5-24-16.

In order to streamline statistics across the board for all “top” reports, the Invitational qualification year has been changed to a regular calendar year (January 1-December 31). This change will facilitate a “shortened” qualification year for the 2017 Invitational. The Top 25 dogs that qualify during the time period of June 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, will be invited to participate in Sacramento in 2017.

The Top 25 Invitational qualifying time frame for the 2018 competition in Nebraska will be from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

Having the shortened qualification year for 2017 ensures that all competitors face a level playing field and the same amount of time in which to qualify. This will save the club a significant amount of money in expensive AKC reports, and the statisticians a significant amount of time and effort in trying to coordinate overlapping competition years, as well as ensuring a proper amount of time in which to verify the final slate of dogs to be invited to the Invitational. This will also allow competitors to track the statistics very easily on their own.

This is the reminder of CSPCA Awards deadline for 2016. The following is a list of the Awards that must be applied for. For a reminder of the requirements for each award please see the CSPCA website, or e-mail the Committee Chairman for further clarification. Unless stated otherwise, we are trying to get all awards turned in by August 3, 2016.

Agility Awards

The AKC top agility dogs report only shows dogs competing at the highest level, so in order to receive recognition it is the responsibility of the owner/handler to keep up with the required information and submit it to the Agility Chairperson. You must send the information from each qualifying leg of a title—score, standard course time, actual time, and placement (if any) to the Agility Chairman by July 1 each year. AKC Outstanding Sportsmanship Award

Any CSPCA member in good standing or any CSPCA Affiliated club may nominate any CSPCA member in good standing for this award based on the AKC Code of Sportsmanship. Nominations open on June 15, and must be received by the current CSPCA Secretary on or before August 1 each year. Nominations must be submitted in writing, and limited to 300 words or less, and signed by the person submitting the nomination. All nominees and nominators will be verified as to being members in good standing of the CSPCA before a nomination is considered. CGC Awards

Top Veteran Award

Dear Members:

Please find below information regarding recent Board approved changes to the Top Veteran Award procedures. We thank Bonnie Stoney and Mike Hardy for their work that led to the approval of these changes.

Top Veteran Award:

The purpose of the Award is to promote the exhibition of Veteran Chinese Shar-Pei seven years of age and older in an Independent Specialty Show, Regional Show and National Specialty Show.

Dogs are tracked via information gathered through the Specialty Show Secretary as AKC does not keep data on Best Veteran wins. Specialty Show Secretaries are to provide to the Top Dog Chairman a complete copy of the show results at the same time as they send show results to AKC. The Specialty Director is to provide to the Top Dog Chairman the names of all approved Specialty Show Secretaries. This is as a backup, in the event that the Specialty Show Secretary fails to provide to the Top Dog Chairman a copy of the show results.

The Top Veteran and its Veteran Opposite Sex are recognized at the National Specialty Awards dinner.

The official competition year is from January 1 to December 31.

The Best Veteran will receive one point for each veteran dog defeated of both sexes. All other veteran class winners will receive one point for each dog defeated of their sex exhibited in their same class.

If any Veteran wins Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex at a Specialty Show they will be awarded one point for each dog defeated of both sexes for BOB (maximum 150 points) and one point for each dog defeated of the same sex for BOS (maximum 100 points). For a Veteran to receive Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex points as a Veteran, they must be entered and exhibited in a veteran class.

Top Dog Committee: This Committee serves under the direction of the CSPCA Board of Directors. The purpose of this Committee is to review show records, to compile a list of dogs and the points they have received as Veteran dogs at Specialty Shows only. Complete show results can be provided by hardcopy (marked catalog) sent by post-al mail, or the complete results can be emailed.

Per our Policy and Procedure Manual:

The purpose of the committee will be to review the club's finances and submit a yearly report to the CSPCA Board of directors by the last day of each fiscal year, December, 31. The committee shall also solicit bids to be turned in to the procurement committee for review and then decided on by the board of directors for an outside auditor to review financial records once every 3 years and every time a new treasurer is elected by the CSPCA membership.

On the years of a financial audit, no financial review will be done. Bids collected by the committee must be sent to the procurement committee by October, 1. The procurement committee must send all acceptable bids to be voted on by the CSPCA board of directors by Nov 1 and the Board of directors must choose and secure an Audit company by December 1. The CSPCA treasurer must turn over all requested financial records to the chosen Auditor by the last day of the year if it is an audit year, which will be every 3 years or if a new treasurer has been elected to begin that year.

The committee shall consist of a chairman and 2 additional committee members decided on by the CSPCA board of directors.

The financial items to be reviewed will be the check book register, bank statements, receipts, electronic spreadsheets including any and all "excel" spreadsheets used to do calculations (ex: paypal, credit cards, etc.) and any other items related to club finances for all transactions.

The review may take place at any designated location agreed on by the committee and treasurer. Examples could include the national specialty, any show that committee members and treasurer will be attending or treasurer's home. An electronic exchange and review of records may be done if all parties of the committee and treasurer can obtain access to electronic records and all parties are agreeable.

Any sensitive information sent via internet would need to be password protected and copy protected. Any sensitive information sent via postal service should be sent registered mail with signature required. Any postage charges will be reimbursed by the CSPCA.

Compensation for expenses will not be offered for this position. However, should compensation for expenses be requested, it must be first approved by the CSPCA Board of directors and will be handled on a case by case basis.

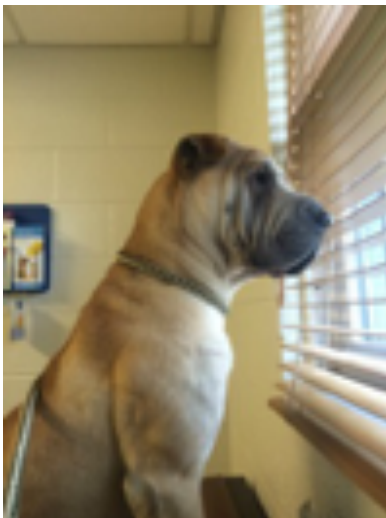

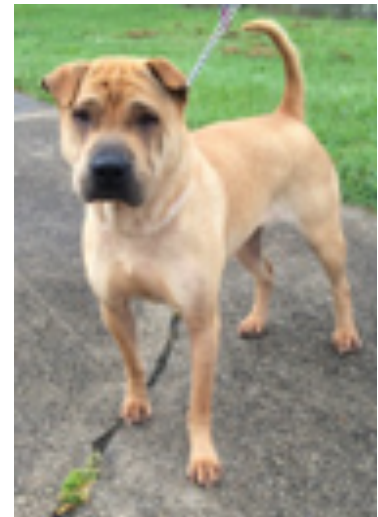

AGILITY GRAND CHAMPION – RECOGNIZING A LIFETIME OF EXCELLENCE

New York, N.Y. – The American Kennel Club (AKC®) is pleased to announce a title designed to celebrate the lifetime achievement of dogs that excel across all AKC agility classes – the Agility Grand Champion (AGCH).

To earn the AGCH title, the following number of qualifying scores must be earned:

- Master Standard & Master Jumper with Weaves – 100 qualifying scores from each class
- Master Fast – 75 qualifying scores
- Time 2 Beat – 75 qualifying scores
- Premier Standard and Premier JWW – 50 qualifying scores from each class

Qualifying scores will be grandfathered and may be earned from either the Regular or Preferred classes or a combination of these classes.

“This truly is a lifetime achievement award,” says Carrie DeYoung, AKC Director of Agility. “We are looking forward to recognizing each of the teams who have demonstrated this relationship and depth of skill over their agility career.”

The new title becomes effective in July. In addition to a title certificate, a plaque will be awarded to each AGCH recipient. Stay tuned for news of the first dogs to achieve this level of excellence.
