Event Operations

Event Operations would like to take this opportunity to update your club on a few items recently passed by the Board of Directors. Any questions should be sent to eventnews@akc.org.

AKC NOHS Enhancements

The following enhancements to the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) have been approved with an April 1, 2017 effective date:

1. Convert the NOHS Polices & Best Practices into NOHS Regulations.
2. Add more structure to the NOHS judging panel requirements:
 - a. Require a different judge to be assigned to the same NOHS group for each day of a weekend/cluster/circuit (approved by the Board at the April 2016 meeting).
 - b. Require a different judge be assigned to the regular and NOHS group/BIS at an event.
 - c. Judges will not be approved to judge a breed in the NOHS and, at the same show, the NOHS Variety Group of which the breed is a part and NOHS Best in Show.
 - d. Single individuals cannot judge all the NOHS groups at an event.
 - e. A judge must be approved for at least one breed in the group to judge the NOHS Group unless they are approved for at least one full group, in which case they may judge any NOHS Group.

Match Regulation Changes

The changes to the Match Regulations have been changed to allow clubs more options when holding a match.

1. Allow Obedience Sanctioned A Matches to be open to all AKC registerable breeds & all FSS recordable breeds.
2. Reduce the required number of Obedience Sanctioned A Matches for a club to become licensed, from two matches down to one successful match.
3. Allow conformation matches held by specialty and group clubs, at their option, to offer competition for:
 - a. Their breed only (specialty clubs only), or
 - b. Breeds within their group, or
 - c. All AKC breeds (including FSS registerable breeds)

Conformation B Match email campaign enhancement:

The AKC has added a free form text box to the conformation B match email announcements being sent out to prospective exhibitors. Following receipt and approval of a conformation B match application by the AKC, the Match Chair will receive an email with a link to their match's AKC email announcement and a free form text box enabling the club to provide specific information for their event. In most cases the Match Chair will have up to 72 hours to add the clubs message. The club can preview the finalized email prior to release. This option was requested by several Match Chairs and enhances the message to new exhibitors, however if a club chooses not to add anything the AKC's promotion of the match will go out as scheduled. These emails have increased the attendance at matches.

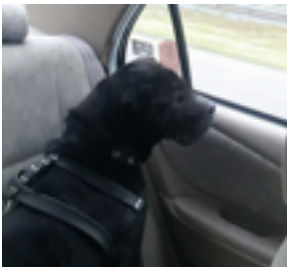

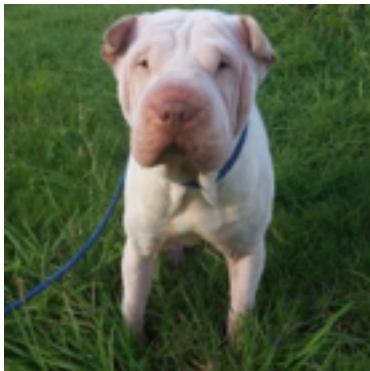
Pearl

Hi, my name is Pearl! I am about 7-8 years old and lived my entire life outside before coming to rescue. I am so happy to be living in a house with comfy beds and people who care about me. Everyone who meets me just loves me and says that I am a sweet girl. I also have some new canine friends at my foster home.

I have been a very good, sweet girl at the veterinarian. I came to rescue with an issue with my back legs. I saw a physical therapist and was referred to an orthopedic surgeon. I have a condition called Grade 4 Bilateral Subluxating Patella. This is a condition where my knee-caps are severely rotated outboard on each of my hind legs. I had limited use of my back legs and had resorted to getting around by dragging my back end like a seal or by hopping on one of my back legs.

I had surgery on my first leg in June and am now going to physical therapy. I am doing really well and can even climb up on the bed now. I also had entropion surgery and was spayed prior to my first orthopedic surgery.

The rescue has been fundraising for my surgeries. We have raised enough to cover my first two surgeries, but need to raise about \$4,000 more for my second surgery and second physical therapy. Yikes!

Rocky came to us as after a tough life on the streets. Rocky loves to play with his Shar-Pei sister in foster and loves toys. He does get a little nervous with small dogs so a home with small dogs might not be the best fit. 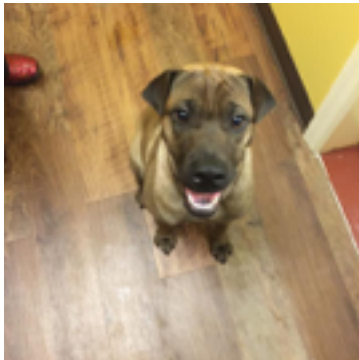

CSPCA Valued Member Award

CSPCA Valued Member Award: The purpose of this award is to increase the recognition of the many important contributions made by CSPCA members to our Club and breed. This award will be given on a quarterly basis (to coincide with the Barker Magazine schedule) to a CSPCA member whose behavior or actions benefit the CSPCA, or reflect positively on the CSPCA or the Chinese Shar-Pei breed. Each recipient of the award will be featured in the next issue of the Barker Magazine with a paragraph describing why he or she was chosen for this award. A photograph will accompany the article.

Any member in good standing can nominate another member in good standing for the valued member award. The nomination is due to the Secretary the 10th of Month in which the nominations are voted on. The nomination will be submitted to the CSPCA secretary in writing by email or by USPS. The nomination must be accompanied with why the member is being nominated and give specific details of what makes this person a valued member. The BOD will vote each quarter (March, June, Sept, Dec) to select one valued member. They will be voted on by secret ballot the week prior to the corresponding BOD meeting. The winner will be announced at the BOD meeting by the secretary. Each year's recipients of the Valued Member Award will be given a certificate signed by the CSPCA President at the Annual National Awards Banquet. The CSPCA Valued Member Award will have a club member designated as a steward to monitor the continuity of the award, and to ensure that the appropriate information on the award is included in each Barker Magazine.

Recipients of this award may be CSPCA members demonstrating long-term service to the Club/breed, or may be a CSPCA member that reacts to an isolated situation in a manner that reflects positively on our breed and Club

Update on SPAID Test

Cornell University Animal Health Diagnostic Center

We know that many people are anxious to get all the information about the new SPAID Test. We still do not have a date that Cornell will go live for accepting samples for testing but we are inching closer and it will definitely be before the end of the year. Please watch the cspca.com website and Facebook page for notices as to when, where, and how to submit samples for DNA testing for the allele that puts Shar-Pei at risk for Shar-Pei Autoinflammatory Disease, which includes Shar-Pei Fever and amyloidosis.

For Our Foreign Members: The test is currently being offered at SLU in Sweden for Shar-Pei outside North and South America.

Health Survey

Reminder- Health Survey on Dr. Vidts's Website

If you haven't done so yet, please take a moment to fill in a health survey on each of your Shar-Pei.

We would like to see as many people participate as possible. Surveys only take about 5-10 minutes to fill out, and the information gathered is invaluable to knowing where to best spend our research dollars on health issues in the breed. You do not need to use the registered name of the dog. Call names will do or number them if you are filling out surveys on more than one dog.

For each health survey that is filled out, at the end of the year, the CSPCA will pay \$2 for each one to the CSPCA Rescue Fund and an additional \$2 per survey to the Chinese Shar-Pei Charitable Trust. Filling out the survey's helps not only know how to spend the research money but also in benefiting two of our programs.

MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE - Deadline November 20, 2016

Due to recent vacancies, the Board is seeking volunteers for the Membership Development Committee. Reminder for our Junior Showmen

We wanted to remind all of our Junior Showman that we have Ernest Albright Junior Handler Memorial Grants. These grants were established to help support and promote our Junior age children to participate in dog shows. There are 3 different grants for Juniors. They are as follows:

1. The Westminster Kennel Club CSPCA Junior Handler Grant \$500.
2. AKC/Eukanuba National Championship Grant \$500
3. The CSPCA Junior Handler National Specialty Grant \$150

You must qualify for the Westminster Kennel Club Grant and the AKC/Eukanuba grants. The rules and qualifications are listed on the CSPCA website. You may qualify for both these grants each year; however those qualifying for both will receive \$500 for the first grant and \$250 for the second grant. The Junior must have been showing a Chinese Shar-Pei when qualifying.

The CSPCA Junior Handler National Specialty Grant is \$150 and can be applied for in multiple years. The qualifications are also listed on the CSPCA website.
