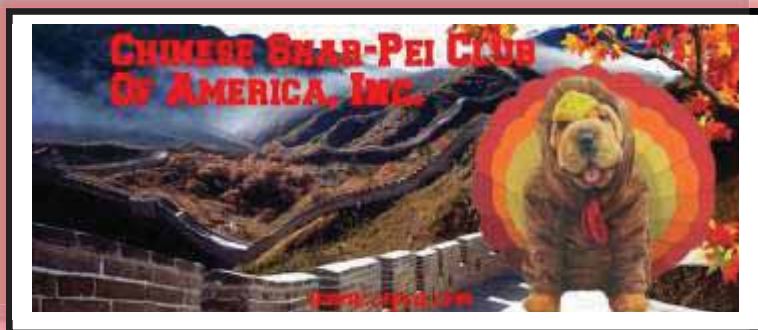


AKC Needs Our Help on Dec. 9-10

Junior Showmanship Grants Reminder

Applications for Ernest Albright Junior Handler Memorial Grants must be submitted to the Juniors Advisors by December 15th. The Ernest Albright Junior Handler Memorial Grants have 3 different grants that can be applied for:

1. The Westminster Kennel Club CSPCA Junior Handler Grant
2. AKC/Eukanuba National Championship Grant
3. The CSPCA Junior Handler National Specialty Grant

The Westminster Kennel Club CSPCA Junior Grant and the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship Grant may be awarded annually to CSPCA Junior Members qualifying for the events and meeting criteria. Each initial individual grant is in the amount of \$500. A CSPCA Junior Member must qualify for the Westminster Kennel Club and AKC/Eukanuba Grants according to the criteria specified by those organizations. A Junior Member may apply for the grants each year they are eligible. In one calendar year, a Junior Member qualifying for both grants may receive the full amount (\$500) for one grant and (\$250) for the second grant. Junior Members may receive a maximum of \$750 for the Westminster and AKC/Eukanuba Grants in one calendar year.

The CSPCA Junior Handler National Specialty Grant is available to every Junior Member attending the Annual National Specialty Show who meets the established criteria. Grant payouts are available in the amount of \$150 and may be applied for and earned multiple years.

New Forms Button on CSPCA Website

We have a new button on the CSPCA website called “Club Forms”. This will come in handy when we have any kind of forms that need to be downloaded , filled out and mailed. You will find it under CSPCA Club Info. We have some forms there now just as a test to be sure that it was going to work properly. This will make it very easy to find and print our National Specialty Forms.

AKC Breed Education Flash Card Project

The AKC Public Education Administrator is making educational flash cards to be used to help children in identifying the different breeds of dogs. They are looking for any picture you would like to share of the Chinese Shar-Pei with them for this purpose. All photos must be accompanied with the filled out and signed AKC Photo Release Form. That form can be found on the CSPCA website www.cspca.com under the “Club Info” button. Click on “Club Forms” and you will find the release there. All you have to do is click on the form, and it should appear at the bottom of your screen so you can save and print it. In order to print the flashcards, the photos must be at least 300 dpi (high resolution). Low resolutions photos do not print well and will probably be rejected for that reason.

No photos of dogs that are currently being actively campaigned. Only retired or deceased show dogs please.
