NOMINATIONS OPEN FOR AKC DELEGATE

AKC Delegate Nomination and Appointment: The CSPCA Delegate to the American Kennel Club shall be selected according to the following timetable and procedure:

In years of the delegate appointment (even numbered years), the BOD will accept nominations for the position of CSPCA Delegate from April 1 - May 31st. Nominations must be made to the CSPCA Secretary in writing by a CSPCA Member in Good Standing and accepted in writing by the nominated delegate. Nominations must be received by May 31st.

Nominees for the position of CSPCA Delegate may choose to address the CSPCA Officers and Directors at a regularly scheduled meeting in June or July. Each nominee, if desired may have ten minutes to ask or answer questions and discuss their qualifications for the position of CSPCA delegate to the AKC. The BOD will elect the CSPCA delegate by majority vote in executive session following the regularly scheduled July meeting. The term of the elected delegate shall begin the following August.

AKC Delegate Duties: The CSPCA Delegate to the American Kennel Club is a non-voting member of the CSPCA Board of Directors whose election and duties are prescribed in Article III, Section 3(b) of the CSPCA Bylaws: The Directors will elect by majority vote, a person to serve at the pleasure of the Board as a Delegate to the American Kennel Club. The American Kennel Club Delegate shall: shall be to represent the Club before The American Kennel Club at meetings of the AKC Delegate body; communicate decisions of the Delegate body to the Club and seek direction from the Board on issues considered by the Delegate body. Such Delegate need not be a member of the Board. The Club shall comply with American Kennel Club rules regarding the credentials and appointments of said Delegate. The term of office shall be two (2) years; each year shall run from August 1st - July 31st. The Delegates term shall be selected in even numbered years. As of March 23.2006 the board approved a \$1500 per year expense allotment.

In addition the AKC Delegate shall:

- Participate in CSPCA BOD meetings scheduled immediately prior to AKC delegate meetings.
- Attend all quarterly meetings of the AKC Delegates at the delegate's expense, and report back to the CSPCA Board of Directors in a timely fashion.
- Report to the CSPCA Board information pertinent to breed matters and other information discussed by the AKC.
- Serve as a liaison between the AKC and the CSPCA.
- Advise the CSPCA Board regarding upcoming AKC votes with request for instructions on how to vote.
- Assist and address concerns of CSPCA members when requested.

Special Announcements

Dear Members of the Chinese Shar-Pei Club of America -

On April 23, the CSPCA Board approved two policies, a Membership Directory Policy and a Privacy Policy. These two Polices are attached/included for your information. These policies were developed by an ad hoc group with the advice of legal counsel. The CSPCA intends to publish a Membership Directory in the Members Only section of the CSPCA's Website on or about September 1, 2018. This Directory will be for everyone's use within the guidelines of these Policies. It is the Board's intention the Membership Directory will be searchable and "read-only". With this notice, each Member is being given the opportunity to decide whether you want only your name in the Directory, or the following information in the Directory; name, address, phone number, email address, membership start date, and membership expiration

date. No action on the part of a Member will signify that Member's consent to have their information published in the Directory. In other words, you do not need to take any action unless you want only your name included in the Membership Directory. Any Member wishing to "opt out" and have only their name appear in the Directory must send a signed statement to the CSPCA Membership Secretary (<u>Bob@cspca.com</u>) no later than July 15, 2018. The Statement should say -

I UNDERSTAND THE LISTING OF MY MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION IS REVOCABLE AT ANY TIME BY WRITING TO THE MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY OF THE CSPCA. I WISH TO ONLY HAVE MY NAME LISTED IN THE MEMBERS ONLY SECTION OF THE CSPCA WEBSITE AND TO OPT OUT FROM LISTING MY MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION,

This Notice is being communicated to CSPCA members by the following four methods prior to July, 2018;

- 1) publishing the policies and plans in The Barker,
- 2) publishing the policies and plans in the Newsletter,
- 3) sending out an email notice to the Members Yahoo List, and
- 4) sending out the email notice to all members who currently receive CSPCA email notices.

Members with email will receive this notification three or four times, and Members who only receive postal mail will receive this notification twice. Future New Members will receive a similar Notification, including the Membership Directory and Privacy Policies in the New Members Handbook which gets mailed to each new member. The New Member packet will also include a postage prepaid postcard giving new members the opportunity to request only their name be listed in the Membership Directory, if desired.

The Membership Secretary will maintain the Membership Directory for the CSPCA. Updates to the Directory will be made by the Membership Secretary at least twice per year.
