CSPCA Matching Funds Fundraiser

At the CSPCA Board Meeting on July 23, 2013, the board approved a Matching Funds program as a fund raiser for the Chinese Shar-Pei Charitable Trust and the CSPCA Rescue Fund. For each dollar that is donated to either of these organizations, the CSPCA will match it up to \$5,000 limit for each organization. Both of these organizations are very worthwhile groups. The Charitable Trust funds health research projects that benefit our breed. The Rescue Fund distributes money yearly to qualified CSPCA affiliated rescue groups to help defray their expenses. They also give money to animal shelters and/or individuals assisting in emergency situations involving our breed. You can now make your donation worth twice the amount during this program. NOTICE TO ALL OUR PAYPAL/CREDIT CARD USERS

If you would like to make a payment with your credit card on the CSPCA website and you "do not" have a PayPal account, Click on the PayPal logo. A CSPCA screen will come up that has the Chinese Shar-Pei Club of America on top. Fill in the "description" field with what payment is for and fill in the "item price". Under "choose way to pay" click on "Don't have a PayPal Account". Hit enter. The next screen has "Pay with a debit or credit card". Fill out all information and hit "continue". Your transaction will be processed.

It has come to our attention if you would like to make a payment with your credit card on the CSPCA website and you also have a PayPal account, special credit card rules apply. Once you use a credit card on PayPal, that credit card becomes associated with your PayPal account on the website. If you try to use it for a regular credit card payment (not PayPal), the payment will not go through. You will get a message that it is an invalid card. You must use a credit card that is not associated with PayPal to make a regular Master Card or Visa payment. This only applies to people with a PayPal account. If you get the message that you are using an invalid card, you will need to use a different credit card or make your payment through PayPal.

*As another reminder, please put a notation in the description line what your payment is for so you can get the proper credit.*
