This is a very special thing we can do to honor those dogs that were given a second chance.

In order for us to make this happen we need two things: 1. Rescue dogs and owners/fosters and 2. the support of YOU. Many of you don't like to come because of the sad stories and the situations many of these dogs came from. Instead of focusing on that, choose to look at what these dogs have overcome and see how they have blossomed in their new homes. Some have become therapy dogs, some have gone on to obedience and agility careers, some are just loved by their families and some get to know love for the first times in their lives. I'm very proud to be a part of that, aren't you?

I know that many of you do come to the parade and have supported it over the years by coming to watch and clap for those entered. Please continue to do so and bring your friends. Many of you sitting out there in the audience have given your time and help and money to rescue, maybe you should see where some of that has ended up and see some of the dogs that have benefited from your help.

New Therapy Dogs In 2012

If, you have a new Therapy Dog for the year of 2012, I will need a **copy** of the official verification (such as Certification or Registration or etc.) stating that your **dog was tested and passed the testing**. A Therapy Dog Pin will be awarded to you and your dog will also be recognized in the Barker. This will also pertain only to CSPCA Members.

*Note: You must send me the verification to receive recognition of a New Therapy Dog

Listed below is all the information that I need to have...asap....here goes:

- 1.) AKC Registered Name...Please also show Prefix (GCH,CH,etc) and Suffix (CGC,TD,VSP,OB Titles/etc).
- 2.) AKC Registration Number.
- 3.) Call Name.
- 4.) Dog or Bitch (D/B).
- 5.) NAME OF OWNER(S)
- 6.) **PICTURE(S) and/or articles** to be displayed at Nationals & in The Barker. I don't care what kind of picture...can be one of your TD doing a TD Event/Visit or just a plain picture. I know it is hard to get TD pics because of the "Photo Authorization/Release Form". We just want to see a pic of your baby! ("articles"mentioned above could be magazine/newspaper/etc.)
- 7.) Copy of Original Current Thrapy Dog National Organization Membership Card...example: TDInc, TDI, etc.
- 8.) Copy of Original Certificate of your (NEW) 2012 AKC Titled Therapy Dog (as it will show the earned date as well) I don't want 2011 nor 2013. We will always be working on the previous year for this award at Nationals.
- 9.) <u>If you have a New, First-Time, 2013 Therapy Dog</u>, I will also need an original copy of your National TD Organization's current Membership Card. This will show your name and your TD's name with member numbers. See above #7 for example.
- 10.) For those members who have a Therapy Dog even though it is not new at this and already has an AKC TD Title or one that has not as of yet earned the title...You may still send me a **picture and/or articles and a current original copy of your National Organization's Membership Card** for The Barker's Special Tribute to our Therapy Shar-Pei and mentioned at the 2013 Nationals.
