Current Wording in the PPM about the Ethics Committee:

Code of Ethics Committee: It is the task of the ethics committee to design a Code of Ethic that each ethical member of the CSPCA will adopt. The committee may also act as a mediator when requested. The policy of the committee is that no charge or complaint or accusation will be accepted unless it also bears the name of the person(s) making the complaint. Nameless accusations will not be acted upon or acknowledged.

New wording for Ethics Committee passed by the Board of Directors on 9-23-14

Code of Ethics Committee:

The committee is to consist of a Chairman and two committee members all appointed by the Board of Directors. They will be responsible for:

1. Designing and update as necessary a Code of Ethics that each member of the CSPCA will adopt.
2. Act as a mediator when requested.
3. Investigate complaints about club members behaving in an unethical way that reflects poorly on our Club and/or is injurious to the CSPCA or its purposes.
4. Investigate complaints filed about breeders listed in the Breeder's Directory. (*Please see Breeder's Directory Committee for more details*)
5. The chairman shall make reports to the Board of Directors with any findings that they think warrant sanctions.
6. The Chairman may be invited to sit in on executive session Board Meetings, when requested to do so by the Board, if the meeting pertains to investigations done by the Ethics Committee.
7. The Chairman shall notify all parties when a sanction is filed against them with all details about the sanction including the start and end dates of the sanction.

The policy of the committee is that no charge, complaint or accusation will be accepted unless it also bears the name of the person(s) making the complaint. Nameless accusations will not be acted upon or acknowledged.

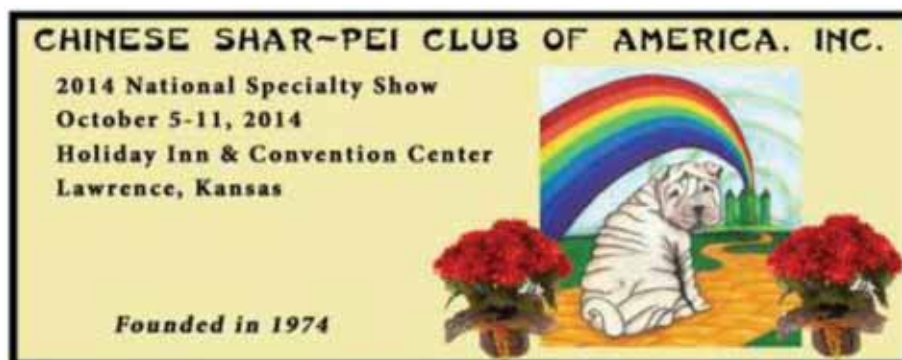
