DID YOU KNOW THAT JUNIOR MEMBERSHIPS ARE FREE?



Do you know a Junior that is showing a Shar-Pei? Are they a member of the CSPCA? There is no reason for them not to be a member as Junior memberships are FREE, as in no cost. You just have to apply for the membership.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP: A junior member is a person living in the United States of America, who is between the ages of 9 and 18 inclusive, and shall be sponsored by a parent or guardian, or by two regular active members provided that parental permission has been granted. He shall enjoy all the privileges of the Club, except that he shall not hold elective office, nor shall he vote. He may automatically convert to regular membership upon his eighteenth birthday. The free membership does not include a copy of The Barker.

We LOVE our Juniors and would love to see more of them in the club. We have several Junior scholarships available and host fun activities at Nationals including some educational events as well.

The CSPCA is a large and diverse organization with no paid employees. Therefore, the efforts of our volunteers are directly responsible for the success of our club and its programs. I believe it is an honor to be able to reward a CSPCA member for distinguished service.

Now it is your opportunity to follow suit and nominate another CSPCA member as YOUR Most Valued Member choice. This award is NOT just something to be passed around amongst friends, in fact is actually our hope that you do NOT do this. Instead, it is for that unsung hero who works for the CSPCA with their heart and soul, who has contributed their time, energy and efforts to the Club, our CSPCA, because of their love for the Breed and the Club which fosters it. It is for a person who is one of those folks who so often works very hard behind the scenes, not asking for or expecting recognition but working because they care, because it is just what they DO. All winners will be announced in The Barker and with a plaque at the CSPCA Awards Program the following year.

All nominations will be submitted twice to the board. After the second submission to the board it will be invalid, however the member submitting the nomination is welcome to resubmit their nomination to the Most Valued Member Chairman. If you miss this deadline, the next deadline will be December 15, 2019.

EDUCATIONAL SEMINARS AT NATIONALS

There will be two opportunities to attend seminars at Nationals. Both seminars are health related concerning the Chinese Shar-Pei. They will be held in Room 130 of the Convention Center. They are both set to begin at 3:00 but that may be later depending on what time the show closes for the day.

Tuesday afternoon - October 22 - Seminar by Rebecca Pentecost, DVM Complications During and After Pregnancy.

Dr. Pentecost is a well-respected veterinarian with a special interest in canine reproduction, neonatal care, minimally invasive surgical techniques, BAER testing and liposuction (for fatty tumor removal). She is active in breeding and showing Chinese Shar-Pei under the kennel name of Shine Shar-Pei. She has bred some of the top winning Shar-Pei in the country.
