### **NEWS ABOUT VICE PRESIDENT'S POSITION**



On March 31, Mike Barker resigned from his position as Vice President of the Club. We would like to thank him for his service to the club and are sorry to see him go. On May 2, 2020 the board voted to fill his vacant position with Lynn Olds. The board waited until after the nominations for officers were closed to fill the position. This was to make sure they did not chose anyone that was running for office to avoid a conflict of interest or show any favoritism for any candidate running for that position in the next term. We want to thank Lynn Olds for agreeing to fulfill the position for the rest of Mike's term which expires on December 31, 2020.

### **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY- JUDGES BALLOTING COMMITTEE**

We have openings for one or two people on the National Judge Balloting Committee. There have been changes made since the last guidelines in the PPM, and there are more changes pending. We now allow all regular members to vote. We are hopeful that, by the next National Judge Election, voting can be done electronically. Everything listed can be done by an exhibitor, except direct contact with the judges, and the signing of the contracts. Therefore, one person who does not show or have dogs shown at National could do all. Otherwise a second person who does not show is needed for judge contact. The current committee will work with the new committee until they are comfortable. Below is an outline of the basic duties:

- 1. Count nominations and email the judges with the highest # to seek their acceptance of the nomination.
- 2. Create a ballot using the 4 to 8 judge names with the highest # of nominations (who have agreed to appear on the ballot)
- 3. Obtain a current list of permit and approved Chinese Shar-Pei judges from AKC
- 4. Create a nomination form
- 5. Contact the Teller to arrange for them to count the votes and either count nominations, or if he is unwilling, have him forward the nominations to you to be counted.
- 6. Send ballots and nomination forms to members with instructions and deadline for returning to the Teller.
- 7. The Teller's report will have assigned the values, ie: Ist choice 3, 2nd choice 2, and 3rd choice I. The judge with the highest overall count should be contacted in an attempt to hire. If accepted, that judge has the choice of judging Best of Breed or dogs and bitches. The 2nd place judge is then contacted and offered the alternate assignment. If the Irst place judge declines, move to 2nd place and so on until you have hired one judge, then proceed to the next in line for the alternate assignment, etc.
- 8. Write the contracts and send to the hired judges.
- 9. Write an annual committee report for the Board. If you are interested in being considered these these positions please contact Wanda Woodlee at wanda.lee46@yahoo.com

This is the reminder of CSPCA Awards deadline for 2020. The following is a list of the Awards that must be applied for. For a reminder of the requirements for each award please see the CSPCA website, or e-mail the Committee Chairman for further clarification. Unless stated otherwise, we are trying to get all awards turned in by **August 4, 2020**.

<u>Agility Awards</u>- The AKC top agility dogs report only shows dogs competing at the highest level, so in order to receive recognition it is the responsibility of the owner/handler to keep up with the required information and submit it to the Agility Chairperson. You must send the information from each qualifying leg of a title—score, standard course time, actual time, and placement (if any) to the Agility Chairman by July 1 each year. **AKC Outstanding Sportsmanship Award**- Any CSPCA member in good standing or any CSPCA Affiliated club may nominate any CSPCA member in good standing for this award based on the AKC Code of Sportsmanship.
