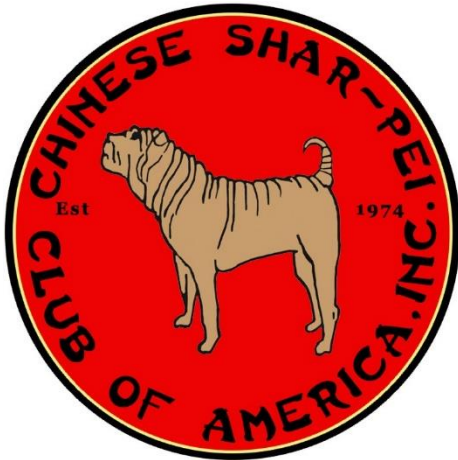

The names of individuals who fail to abide by these rules will be given to future hotels with the intent of being refused occupancy. SINCE THE HOST HOTEL IS ALSO DESIGNATED THE "SHOW GROUNDS" AN INDIVIDUAL CAN BE TAKEN BEFORE AN AKC EVENT COMMITTEE FOR NOT COMPLYING WITH THE RULE TO LEAVE YOUR HOTEL ROOM IN PROPER CONDITION."

CSPCA Pet Policy Agreement

- I agree to abide with all hotel pet policies.
- **Housekeeping and Room Inspection:** I agree to make my room available to hotel housekeeping staff, CSPCA room inspection committee members, show committee members, and CSPCA Board members at all times and agree to not use the "Do Not Disturb" sign or any "Go Green" options which allow skipping housekeeping services.
- I understand my room will be inspected periodically during my stay.
- I will make every effort to have my dog(s) current rabies vaccination certificate in my possession when traveling. Dogs should be free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases.
- No dog shall be left uncrated in a hotel room in the absence of the room occupant at any time.
- Plastic covering must be placed under all crates.
- A blanket or sheet must be placed on top of the hotel bed linens.
- There will be no grooming of dogs in the hotel guest rooms.
- No dogs should be washed in hotel bathtubs, and hotel towels should not be used on dogs for drying them or any other purpose.
- Dog(s) must always be on a controlled leash including flexi-leads when not inside of the guest hotel room.
- Dog(s) must only be walked in the designated pet area(s) of the hotel grounds.
- I am responsible for cleaning up after my pet on hotel grounds and properly dispose of the waste in designated containers. Anyone found not cleaning up after their pet will be reported to the show committee.
- Damages caused by my dog(s) to my room, its furnishings, or any other part of the hotel are my sole responsibility. I understand that my account may be charged by the hotel to make restitution of such damages. Guest rooms are subject to damage inspection at any time and upon checkout.
- If the pet fee is waived and your room needs a deep clean due to doggie smells, you may be charged a cleaning fee by the hotel according to the hotel policy.
- **Noise/Disruptive complaints:** If hotel management receive any complaints about my dog(s) by continual barking disrupting other occupants of the hotel I agree to take care of the matter immediately. Continual complaints may subject to being removed by the hotel.
- If I am found by the committee members or hotel staff of damages, I understand I may be reported to AKC and actions may be taken against me in accordance with AKC rules and I may be subject to a bench hearing, suspension or fine. In addition, offenders may be censured, held in suspension of CSPCA membership or expelled from CSPCA membership should the circumstances warrant.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

All persons entering these dog shows/events, hereby waive any claim for damages against the show-giving club, its members or the show secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The club(s) is/are solely responsible for determining if the said animal is in distress.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property while at or on the show grounds, or in transit to or from the show nor assume any responsibility for injury to children.

The hosting club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the club, site or show secretary will be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss. It is understood that all dogs at this show are in the care and custody of the owners or owner's agents during the entire show week.

There shall be no drilling or intensive/abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.

Dog(s) must always be on a controlled leash including flexi-leads when not inside the guest hotel room

Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs that they are exhibiting, or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on our show site. Clean up tools and supplies will be available at each ring and at other convenient locations through-out the show grounds.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Everyone using this facility is expected to keep and leave the area clean. Garbage containers will be provided for your use. All dog waste must be picked up immediately.

Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety.

RAMP – All dogs will be judged on Ramp.

"A Recording Fee of 50 cents and a \$3.00 event fee (included in entry fee) will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club show. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only." (Chapter 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules).

CANADIAN/INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There will be **no refunds** for duplicate entries. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, fax or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancelation of entries after the published closing date.

Entries must be made on an Official AKC entry form or photocopy of the Official AKC entry form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side or they cannot be accepted.

Confirmation of Entry will be sent to the email address(s) on the Official AKC entry form within 48 hours of receipt, if you do not receive email confirmation please contact show secretary. Judging Program/Schedule will be sent after close of entries.

Points may be awarded to RWD & RWB at the National Specialty.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS: All Dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and an owner or co-owner of the dog.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: Effective for all shows held on or after July1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the judging at this show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – Involving Single Dog Entries

These classes are judged between Winners Bitch and Best of Breed, class winners are eligible for Best of Breed

Veteran Dog - Brushcoat 7 years and under 10 years	Veteran Dog - Brushcoat 10 years and over
Veteran Dog - Horsecoat 7 years and under 10 years	Veteran Dog - Horsecoat 10 years and over

NON-REGULAR (Additional) CLASSES – Involving Multiple Dog Entries – National Only

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and up to **three** of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class; the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same Breed with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace #1, "Brace #2, etc.

CLASS INFORMATION - Junior Showmanship

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - (*effective date of January 1, 2018*) For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior wins with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC Judges Education Department

Bitches in season are not eligible to be shown in Junior Showmanship Classes.

At a Specialty show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season or a veterinarian's excuse may be replaced by another dog meeting the same ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form.

Calling All Juniors Aging Out of Juniors Before 2024 Nationals- Sept 20, 2024

If you are a Junior and this is your last year to qualify as a Junior at the CSPCA National Specialty Shows, we want to recognize your final year as a Junior at our Nationals. Immediately after Junior Showmanship is over, we would like all Juniors aging out of Juniors to take a final lap around the ring in a Juniors Farewell Parade. It is our final recognition of your Junior's journey.

There is no cost to enter the Parade but you must send in the entry form and be entered in a Regular Juniors Class.

Entry form is located at the end of this premium.

Note to All Juniors- Please stay until the end of this Parade so that we can get a group photo of all our Juniors.

For a Chinese Shar-Pei Futurity puppy to be eligible to compete in the Futurity, it must meet all the following requirements:

1. Be from an eligible litter which was properly and timely nominated;
2. Has been individually nominated before it reached the age of four months;
3. Be owned /co-owned by a member in good standing of the CSPCA, Inc.;
4. Must be entered in one of the regular classes of the National Specialty;
5. Not be bred, owned, co-owned, leased or handled by the judge or member of his or her immediate family, nor sired by or out of a Chinese Shar-Pei owned, co-owned or leased by the judge or member of his or her immediate family.

Copies of all pertinent information and correspondence regarding the nomination (including proof of all payments of nomination fees), ownership and nomination acceptance of the Futurity puppy must be available to the Futurity/Maturity Director in case of any errors, protests or conflicts. Failure to do so could result in the Chinese Shar-Pei in question being disqualified from competition due to lack of proof of eligibility. The National Specialty Show Chairperson will be responsible to rule on any protest or conflict regarding an entry to the Futurity/Maturity based upon the evidence and/or documentation at hand. The Chairperson's ruling will be final without further appeal or protest. Entry Fee \$25.00.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY SHOW TROPHIES AND AWARDS.

Breed Challenge Trophies - Challenge trophies are offered for competition at the CSPCA Annual National Specialty Show. For permanent possession these trophies must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. The names of the winning dogs will be engraved on the trophy and held by the CSPCA, Inc. until it is won outright. Trophies introduced after January 1, 2000 may not carry any personal or kennel names, only dedications to deceased individuals or dogs will be allowed. The current challenge trophies that are offered are as follows:

Best of Breed - The Founders Challenge Trophy was established in 1994 in tribute to the founders of the Chinese Shar-Pei Club of America, Inc. The original Founders Challenge Trophy was donated by Bertram and Ann Hickman and retired in 2016 by Jeff and Vicki Mauk. A replacement trophy was established in 2017. A "Shar-Pei statue mounted on a wooden base with a wooden carrying case," and offered by the CSPCA, Inc. through the generosity of Jeff and Vicki Mauk.

Best of Winners - The AKC Delegates Challenge Trophy was established in 1996. This trophy is in commemoration of AKC recognition of the Chinese Shar-Pei on August 1, 1992. The original trophy was damaged and replaced in 2014, a Dannyquest sculpture "What A Handsome Fellow" set on a base. PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of the sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- **Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.**
- **Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.**
- **Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior**
- **The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.**
- **The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.**
- **The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.**
- **The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.**
- **The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.**
- **Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of the competitors.**
- **Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.**
- **Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.**
- **Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of his breeding stock.**
- **Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.**
- **Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.**
- **Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.**
