BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS: All Dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and an owner or co-owner of the dog.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of the judging at this show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6).

NON-REGULAR SINGLE DOG CLASSES:

Neutered/Spayed animals can compete in these classes for both dogs & bitches
Winners of these classes will compete for Best of Breed

Veterans for dogs seven years old or older, classes for both
Brushcoat & Horsecoat. Neutered/Spayed animals can compete.

Classes 7 - 10 years 10 years & over

Best of Breed/Variety Competition

NON-REGULAR CLASSES: Multiple Dog Entries (NATIONALS ONLY)

These classes are not eligible for Best of Breed & will be judged after BOB.

NON-REGULAR (Additional) CLASSES – Involving Multiple Dog Entries – National Only

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and up to **three** of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed

Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class; the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same Breed with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, “Brace #1, “Brace #2, etc.

- ✓ **Entry fee** shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred. All fees are payable in US funds only.
- ✓ **Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms** and photocopies of the entry without the Agreement and Rules from the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- ✓ **Entries will not be accepted** without fees or signatures. There will be **NO refunds** for duplicate entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. IF you enter online you will get a system generated e-mail with directions on how to pay. That is confirmation that your entry went through. When entries are processed each exhibitor will get a confirmation e-mail showing the entire entry and will have a chance to make changes or corrections.
- ✓ **Entries will not be accepted** without fees or signatures.
- ✓ **Errors on Entry Blanks:** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- ✓ **Show-giving Club,** Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs, or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children under the control of parents or guardians.
- ✓ **A recording fee of** .50 cents and an event fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club, Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. - ✓ **All dogs** must be held on leash except when in the exercise area or crated.
- ✓ **Judges** will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

- ✓ All persons entering these dog shows/events, hereby waive any claim for damages against the show-giving club, its members or the show secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The club(s) is/are solely responsible for determining if the said animal is in distress.
- ✓ Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- ✓ Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**
- ✓ The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property while at or on the show grounds, or in transit to or from the show nor assume any responsibility for injury to children.
- ✓ The hosting club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the club, site or show secretary will be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss. It is understood that all dogs at this show are in the care and custody of the owners or owner's agents during the entire show week.
- ✓ There shall be no drilling or intensive/abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.
- ✓ Dog(s) must always be on a controlled leash including flexi-leads when not inside the guest hotel room
- ✓ Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs that they are exhibiting, or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on our show site. Clean up tools and supplies will be available at each ring and at other convenient locations through-out the show grounds.
- ✓ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- ✓ Everyone using this facility is expected to keep and leave the area clean. Garbage containers will be provided for your use. All dog waste must be picked up immediately.
- ✓ Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety.
- ✓ **RAMP** – All dogs will be judged on Ramp.
- ✓ **Note to Foreign Exhibitors:**
- ✓ Effectively August 1, 2024, **ALL DOGS** imported or traveling into/returning to the US are required to but not limited to the following:
 - ✓ Appear healthy upon arrival
 - ✓ Be at least six months of age
 - ✓ Have an ISO compatible microchip implanted for ID purposes, and
 - ✓ Be accompanied by a CDC Dog Import Form online submission receipt (no cost.)
 - ✓ The form will be available on the CDC and AKC sites, when available. For all dogs being exhibited from outside the US, a new form will need to be completed each time they cross into the US.
 - ✓ This new ruling is still in a flux state and each owner/breeder/exhibitor is responsible for keeping up to date on this ruling, so you are not surprised as you attempt to cross into the US with dogs.
 - ✓ Here is a link to the CDC website with more information on this topic:

NATIONAL AWARDS

Breed Challenge Trophies - Challenge trophies are offered for competition at the CSPCA Annual National Specialty Show. For permanent possession these trophies must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. The names of the winning dogs will be engraved on the trophy and held by the CSPCA, Inc. until it is won outright. Trophies introduced after January 1, 2000 may not carry any personal or kennel names, only dedications to deceased individuals or dogs will be allowed. The current challenge trophies that are offered are as follows:

Best of Breed - The Founders Challenge Trophy was established in 1994 in tribute to the founders of the Chinese Shar-Pei Club of America, Inc. The original Founders Challenge Trophy was donated by Bertram and Ann Hickman and retired in 2016 by Jeff and Vicki Mauk. A replacement trophy was established in 2017. A "Shar-Pei statue mounted on a wooden base with a wooden carrying case," and offered by the CSPCA, Inc. through the generosity of Jeff and Vicki Mauk.

A replacement trophy was established in 2022 by Jeff and Vicki Mauk.

Best of Winners - The AKC Delegates Challenge Trophy was established in 1996. This trophy is in commemoration of AKC recognition of the Chinese Shar-Pei on August 1, 1992. The original trophy was damaged and replaced in 2014, a Dannyquest sculpture "What A Handsome Fellow" set on a base. The replacement trophy was offered by the CSPCA, Inc. through the generosity of Cathi Schneider DiGiacomo, the CSPCA, Inc.'s first AKC Delegate.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor - The original Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Challenge Trophy donated by Vicky Teshera was retired by Teresa Turner in 2010. A replacement trophy was established in 2011. A Dannyquest sculpture set on a base, and offered by the CSPCA, Inc. through the generosity of Theresa Turner.

Best Puppy in Sweepstakes - The Walter "Dugan" Skinner Memorial trophy was established in 1991. A Silver tone Revere Bowl set on a Wooden Base and Offered by the CSPCA, Inc. in memory of Walter "Dugan" Skinner.

Best Brood Bitch – The CSPCA Brood Bitch Challenge Trophy was established this year at the 2018 National Specialty. A Dannyquest sculpture set on a base offered by the CSPCA through the generosity of Barbara Ann LaVere and Tammy Bohlke in honor of all the past beautiful winning Brood Bitches.

Best Stud Dog - The Relic Stud Dog Challenge Trophy : BIS RBIS MBISS MVBISS GCHG BluRubEin Aged To Perfection ROM Awarded to BEST STUD DOG. Presented to the Chinese Shar-Pei Club of America National Specialty Show in 2023 through the generosity of Joy Lockey, Rosie Steinke, Domino Parker and Grace Fritz and those who hold his offspring near and dear to their hearts.

***AWARDS OF MERIT**

The Judge may, at his/her discretion, select a certain number of dogs and/or bitches to receive an "Award of Merit". Novice Junior Class: For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition.

Open Senior Class: For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition.

MASTER CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten First Places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry without charge, the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

- ✓ Bitches in season are not eligible to be shown in Junior Showmanship Classes.

2. Has been individually nominated before it reached the age of four months;
3. Be owned /co-owned by a member in good standing of the CSPCA, Inc.;
4. Must be entered in one of the regular classes of the National Specialty;
5. Not be bred, owned, co-owned, leased or handled by the judge or member of his or her immediate family, nor sired by or out of a Chinese Shar-Pei owned, co-owned or leased by the judge or member of his or her immediate family.

Copies of all pertinent information and correspondence regarding the nomination (including proof of all payments of nomination fees), ownership and nomination acceptance of the Futurity puppy must be available to the Futurity/Maturity Director in case of any errors, protests or conflicts. Failure to do so could result in the Chinese Shar-Pei in question being disqualified from competition due to lack of proof of eligibility. The National Specialty Show Chairperson will be responsible to rule on any protest or conflict regarding an entry to the Futurity/Maturity based upon the evidence and/or documentation at hand. The Chairperson's ruling will be final without further appeal or protest. Entry Fee \$25.00.

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
