# UPDATE: COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SPAID CHEEK SWAB TESTS

I have been in contact with the doctor heading the research program at CSU regarding the SPAID swab samples that were sent summer/fall of 2023 after the contaminated batch was re-routed from the initial batch to Sweden University. I know several members had sent in samples and had lost hope of ever getting those results, myself included. I have a wonderful update for everyone!! I have spoken to the leader of that department and they have had several hurdles, but are finally getting all of the bugs worked out of the system. I have



expressed the frustration of lack of communication along the process on others behalf. The large disconnect was that they were under the understanding that the samples were sent in for purely research purposes, not that people were wanting these results in a timely fashion. She apologized and assured me that none of the samples have been forgotten or passed over. Everyone should be receiving their results via email in approximately 6 weeks.

In addition to this exciting news, they will also be accepting cheek swab submissions for both SPAID variants (CNV and MTBP), POAG and PLL in the summer. We spoke in depth about the expectations and process of this test. You will be able to order the test via their website, a swab kit will be sent to your address, you will send in the sample and the results will be emailed to you in a 4-6 week turnaround time. They are still finalizing the price and packages that will be offered. When I get further information about pricing and bundles I will reply here to keep the thread clean.

As I stated in the CHIC update, POAG/PLL are required test for the Chinese Shar Pei CHIC and SPAID is an "Optional But Recommended" test. Keep in mind, the terminology "optional but recommended" is not our choosing, that is what OFA and AKC have chosen for not required testing. Now, OFA has registries for both the CNV and MTBP variants so owners will hopefully register the results with OFA. The motive with this is to allow us to pull reports, see the true standings of these tests across our breed and gather data to be able to cross reference with other scientific research in hopes of one day coming to a conclusion with these tests. To certify and register your SPAID results with OFA you need to fill out the "DNA Based Genetic Disease" application found on OFA's website and submit it with a copy of your dog's SPAID results.

If anyone has a dog's test results that they are wanting on an expedited timeline from Colorado State University please reach out to me directly as we may be able to get a small list released sooner. If you can wait the 6 weeks, please do so to not slow down the process for others unnecessarily.
