Officers & Directors Ballots

In accordance with the Bylaws, ballots will be mailed no later than September 30. Be sure to look for your ballot in the mail. Only Individual, Household and Lifetime members are eligible to vote and you must have been a member in good standing on July 1, to receive a ballot. The ballot must be received by the designated agent or teller by October 31 to be valid.

Please make sure to put the names of the voters in the return address area of the envelope along with your mailing address. This is how the teller determines if you are an eligible voter. If that information is not listed in the return address on the envelope addressed to the teller, there is no way for the teller to know if you are a legitimate voter.


