RV PARKING:

RV Spots are only available for nights during an MPEC event. They are reserved first come.

Cost: \$75/night for a 50-amp site and \$40/night for a 30-amp site. There is a two-night minimum.

- All RV spots by Ray Clymer Exhibit Hall have water hookups.
- All Grass RV spots by Ray Clymer Exhibit Hall have 30-amp plugs,
- All A spots on concrete lot have 50-amp plugs and B spots have 30-amp plugs.
- All grass RV spots by Ray Clymer Exhibit Hall are 15' x 45'.
- All Concrete RV spots are 20' x 33'.

The closest dump station to the RV spots is the Wichita Bend RV Park located at 300 Central Freeway (I-44 at Texas Travel Information Exit). The dump station is located at the south end of the park.

The event includes a nice dinner and catalog of the Top 25 dogs' that are entered. The Top 25 Chinese Shar Pei who accept the invitation to participate are judged by a panel of three judges and the Top scoring dogs of the evening are then awarded according to their total scores.
