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## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Savvy Show Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. Savvy Show Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.

The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship, according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch may be entered separately in one of the regular or non-regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class; The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

For a Chinese Shar-Pei Futurity puppy to be eligible to compete in the Futurity, it must meet all the following requirements:

1. Be from an eligible litter which was properly and timely nominated;
2. Has been individually nominated before it reached the age of four months;
3. Be owned /co-owned by a member in good standing of the CSPCA, Inc.;
4. Must be entered in one of the regular classes of the National Specialty;
5. Not be bred, owned, co-owned, leased or handled by the judge or member of his or her immediate family, nor sired by or out of a Chinese Shar-Pei owned, co-owned or leased by the judge or member of his or her immediate family.

Copies of all pertinent information and correspondence regarding the nomination (including proof of all payments of nomination fees), ownership and nomination acceptance of the Futurity puppy must be available to the Futurity/Maturity Director in case of any errors, protests or conflicts. Failure to do so could result in the Chinese Shar-Pei in question being disqualified from competition due to lack of proof of eligibility. The National Specialty Show Chairperson will be responsible to rule on any protest or conflict regarding an entry to the Futurity/Maturity based upon the evidence and/or documentation at hand. The Chairperson's ruling will be final without further appeal or protest. Entry Fee \$25.00.

**Breed Perpetual Trophies** - Perpetual trophies are offered for competition at the CSPA Annual National Specialty Show. The names of the winning dogs will be engraved on the trophy and held by the CSPA, Inc.

**Best of Breed** - The Founders Perpetual Trophy was established in 1994 in tribute to the founders of the Chinese Shar-Pei Club of America, Inc. The original Founders Challenge Trophy was donated by Bertram and Ann Hickman and retired in 2024 by Jeff and Vicki Mauk. A replacement trophy was established in 2025, a "Shar-Pei statue mounted on a wooden base with a wooden carrying case," and offered by the CSPA, Inc.

**Best of Winners** - The AKC Delegates Perpetual Trophy was established in 1996. This trophy is in commemoration of AKC recognition of the Chinese Shar-Pei on August 1, 1992. The original trophy was damaged and replaced in 2014, a Dannyquest sculpture "What A Handsome Fellow" set on a base. The replacement trophy was offered by the CSPA, Inc. through the generosity of Cathi Schneider DiGiacomo, the CSPA, Inc.'s first AKC Delegate.

**Best Bred-By-Exhibitor** - The original Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Perpetual Trophy donated by Vicky Teshera was retired by Teresa Turner in 2010. A replacement trophy was established in 2011. A Dannyquest sculpture set on a base, and offered by the CSPA, Inc. through the generosity of Theresa Turner.

**Best Puppy in Sweepstakes** - The Walter "Dugan" Skinner Memorial trophy was established in 1991. A Silver tone Revere Bowl set on a Wooden Base and Offered by the CSPA, Inc. in memory of Walter "Dugan" Skinner.

**Best Brood Bitch** - The CSPA Brood Bitch Perpetual Trophy was established at the 2018 National Specialty. A Dannyquest sculpture set on a base offered by the CSPA through the generosity of Barbara Ann LaVere and Tammy Bohlke in honor of all the past beautiful winning Brood Bitches.

## **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**RESERVE JUNIOR HANDLER:** After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):** There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

**Calling All Juniors Aging Out of Juniors Before 2027 National – October 8, 2027:** If you are a Junior and this is your last year to qualify as a Junior at the CSPCA National Specialty Shows, we want to recognize your final year as a Junior at our Nationals. Immediately after Junior Showmanship is over, we would like any Junior aging out of Juniors to take a final lap around the ring in a 'Junior's Farewell Parade.' It is our final recognition of your Junior's journey. There is no cost to enter the Parade but you must send in the entry form and be entered in a Regular Juniors Class. Entry Form is located at the end of this premium.
